

HOUSE RULES



§1 Scope

The house rules shall apply to all equipment and facilities in the enclosed site, including all entrances and exits (hereinafter „the venue“) and parking areas for the entire period of the event subject to admission on 15 and 16 September 2018, for which the venue is used.

§2 Entry checks

1. The security team set up by the organiser is authorised to investigate whether persons pose a security risk due to alcohol or drug use, or due to an infringement of the prohibitions specified in §3. The security team is authorised to check clothing or containers brought onto the premises, with the consent of the person being checked.
2. Persons who do not hold a valid ticket, or who pose a security risk or refuse to consent to being searched must be refused entry and prevented from entering the venue.

§3 Prohibitions

All visitors to the event are prohibited from bringing or carrying the following items or from doing the following:

1. Any liquid in any kind of container or packaging (drinking water will be available at the event area, marked on the venue map).
2. All food items, either hot or cold, in any kind of packaging
3. Travelling bags, large backpacks and other large pieces of luggage
4. All illegal drugs or substances
5. Weapons of any kind, as well as items that can be used as weapons
6. Any kind of knife, thrust weapon, jackknife, etc.
7. Any kind of firearm, catapult, etc.
8. Gas spray cans, caustic, flammable, colouring substances or vessels containing substances that impair health or are highly flammable – exception: commercially available pocket lighters;
9. Any kind of explosives, fireworks, firecrackers, smoke bombs, smoke powder, flares, pyrotechnics, etc.
10. Furniture, tents, camping equipment
11. Any kind of chairs, stools or seats, etc.
12. Any kind of tables or benches
13. Any kind of barbecue or barbecuing devices
14. Parasols, sunshades, etc.
15. Noisemakers, horns, etc.
16. Laser pointers, flashlights, etc.
17. Remote control toys such as cars, aeroplanes, helicopters, etc.
18. Drones as well as other flying objects such as balloons, sky lanterns, etc.
19. Large flags, poles, large banners, placards, etc.
20. Selling or disseminating racist, xenophobic, extreme right-wing or political propaganda material as well as similar slogans
21. Any promotional, commercial, political or religious items, including banners, signs, symbols and leaflets;
22. Bicycles, scooters, skateboards
23. Pets are not permitted
24. Photographic cameras, video cameras or other audio or visual recording equipment (except those used for private purposes or journalists who have permission from the organiser)
25. Structures and fittings not intended for general use, in particular fences, walls, barriers, lighting installations, trees, masts of all kinds for climbing on or over
26. Selling goods and tickets or distributing printed material
27. Relieving themselves anywhere except for the toilets
28. Standing on seats in the spectator areas
29. Cigarettes and cigarette butts must not be thrown on the grass
30. Food and drink must not be brought onto the premises
31. The event area is located on a military site that stands under special conservation obligations. Thereby many measures have been set to fulfill these requirements. For example, gophers' dens are specially protected. For safety and environmental reasons it is strictly prohibited to embed objects in the ground (no hammering or drilling), pitch up tents or install sunshades in any form. The event area has been inspected by experts. Nevertheless, if relics of war, munition or practice ammunition is found they shall **NOT** be touched or moved. Do not panic, the reference must be marked and shut off at short notice by a person until the security team arrives. The potential find must be reported to the staff.

§4 Actions in the case of poor weather conditions

The venue is a grassy surface with a hard substructure. We recommend that our guests bring waterproof clothing. Small umbrellas may be used at the venue. If the event has to be cancelled, notice of the cancellation may only be given at the announced starting time and is only valid if declared by the organisation management on site. The organisation management reserves the right to wait an appropriate length of time corresponding to the weather forecast when the event is officially started or cancelled.

In the unlikely event the race is cancelled or abandoned, all details and procedures will be communicated via the Red Bull Air Race channels, websites and the large screens on-site. In case of doubt, please visit www.redbullairrace.com. If the entire programme is cancelled on the day of the race due to poor weather conditions, visitors will be refunded the full price of their respective ticket (excluding Sky Lounge and AviatorClub). If the race is started and the programme is cancelled during the race due to poor weather conditions, the race is considered as carried out. Should there be any changes,

Red Bull Air Race and the Local Committee will determine the refund policy and provide information on all Red Bull Air Race channels, websites and the large screens on-site. The refund policy for Sky Lounge and AviatorClub ticket holders will be determined at the event. Poor weather conditions, such as rain, do not automatically mean the race will be cancelled. It is possible for racing aircraft to fly in the rain. Therefore, please bring suitable clothing. All refund policies are based on the announced event programme.

§5 Behaviour at the venue

1. All persons entering the venue must behave in such a way that no one else is harmed, endangered or – to a greater extent than is inevitable in the circumstances – impaired or harassed.
2. The organiser has established the security team to ensure the event runs smoothly. All persons who enter the site must obey instructions from the security team, as well as those of the organiser themselves.
3. Any visual or auditory impairments that occur during the event do not entitle the holder to reclaim the entrance fee.
4. All entrances and exits, as well as emergency, escape and rescue routes are to be kept clear at all times.
5. Rubbish, packaging material and empty containers must be disposed of in the rubbish bins located at the venue.

§6 Liability

You attend the venue at your own risk. The organiser is not liable for personal injury, damage to property, loss of items or valuables. Sports events may cause damage to hearing or other health issues based on the given sound intensity. The organiser is not liable for any damages occurring. Hearing protection will be handed out for free to the guests at the Info Points.

§7 Infringements

Persons who, as a result of their behaviour, impair or endanger the security and organisation of the event, may be banned for the entire duration of the event with the involvement of the police.

§8 Publication

The house rules are made known via notices at the ticket office as well as the entrances and exits and the access roads of the enclosed premises.

§9 Behaviour in the parking area

1. By purchasing the parking ticket, a contract of use is concluded for the day of the event.
2. Parking area: use at your own risk, applies to all parking areas provided for the Red Bull Air Race
3. A parking fee is payable. Parking costs € 5 per car per day.
4. By entering/driving through the parking area, the visitor unconditionally acknowledges the parking regulations, as well as the relevant statutory and official regulations.
5. Instructions from the security team are to be obeyed. In this case, reference is made to the domiciliary right, in particular.
6. The Road Traffic Act (StVO) applies in the parking area. Only approved vehicles with registration plates may be driven and parked in the parking area.
7. For safety and environmental reasons it is strictly prohibited to embed objects in the ground. Camping, pitching tents, installing sunshades and loitering are prohibited.
8. The organizer is in no way liable for the conduct of third parties, also not for theft, burglary, damage, etc. regardless of whether these third parties are authorised or unauthorised to be in the parking area.
9. The organizer is only liable for material damage if it was caused intentionally or grossly negligently by the organizer or his assistants.
10. A failure to comply with the regulations may result in a chargeable towing away fee.
11. Driving on the terrain is at your own risk.
12. Driving on the terrain is only permitted at walking pace.
13. You are located on a meadow area with typical equivalent unevenness for this type of terrain.
14. The organizer assumes no liability for items taken into or found in the parking area.

§10 Film- and photo rights

Please be aware that by entering the event area, you consent to your voice, name, and/or likeness being recorded and used, without compensation, in photographs and/or audiovisual productions for use in any and all media, for any purpose (be it commercial, promotional or otherwise), whether now known or hereafter devised, in perpetuity and you release Red Bull Air Race (or production partner), its affiliates, assignees and licensees from any liability whatsoever of any nature. If you do not agree to the foregoing, please do not enter the event area.
